FREDERIC TRENCH, of Woodlawn (*See above, page 2*), b. 1720 ; d. 27 November 1797 ; m. (August 1754) Mary (eldest daughter and co-heiress of Francis Sadlier, Esq., of Sopwell Hall), who died 1819.

[N.B.—Her sister and joint co-heiress, Catherine, married, 1st, John Bury, Esq., of Shannon Grove, father of 1st Earl of **CHARLEVILLE**, and 2nd, Henry Prittie, 1st Lord **DUNALLEY**.]

1. **FREDERIC**, b. 1755 (created, 27 December 1800, Baron **ASHTOWN**, of Moate, in County Galway, in Peerage of Ireland, with remainder, on failure of his issue male, to the heirs male of his father) ; o. s. p. 1 May 1840 ; m. (25 May 1785) Elizabeth, only daughter of R. Robinson, M.D.
2. **FRANCIS**, b. 5 October 1758 ; d. November 1829 ; m. (11 June 1802) Mary, 2nd daughter of Henry Mason, Esq., of Shrewsbury.
 1. **FREDERIC**, b. October 1803 ; d. young.
 2. **FREDERIC MASON**, 2nd Baron **ASHTOWN**, b. 25 December 1804 ; m. 1st (29 August 1831) Henrietta (youngest daughter of Thomas Phillips Cosby, Esq., of Stradbally Hall, Queen's County), who died 25 February 1845 ; m. 2nd (10 February 1852) Elizabeth, second daughter and co-heiress of Richard Oliver Gascoigne, Esq., of Parlington, County York, and Castle Oliver, County Limerick.  1. **FREDERIC SYDNEY CHARLES**, Hon., b. 18 April 1839 ; m. (30 April 1867) Lady Anne Le Poer Trench, eldest daughter of William Thomas, 3rd Earl of **CLANCARTY**.
