

studied medicine until the breaking out of the Civil War, when he joined his brother's company, became a Lieutenant, and finally Adjutant of the 28th Louisiana Regiment. After the War he graduated at the Baltimore College of Dental Surgery, practiced a year or two in Louisiana, then removed to San Antonio, Texas, where he remained until 1874, when he went abroad and established himself at Neuchâtel and later at Zürich, in Switzerland. Finding the winters too severe, he established a winter practice in Cannes, in the South of France. In 1882 he retired, in favor of his brother, returned to America, and located at Santa Barbara, Cal., where he still (1897) resides. He m.
