

- 1664 I. Ann, b. Oct. 21, 1820; m. John S. Williams, Feb. 20, 1844; he was b. Jan. —, 1821, in Scotland; d. 1892, at San Francisco, Cal. He was a builder. On Feb. 20, 1854, they removed to San Francisco; in July, 1863, she returned East, on account of the serious illness of her mother, and in September, 1863, removed to Hackensack; in 1882 she went to live with her daughter, Mrs. Russell B. Lawrence, at Corona, then Richmond Hill, L. I., and in April, 1896, they removed to Moss Hill, South Norwalk, Conn. Issue:

- 1671 II. Hetty (Hester), b. Oct. 2, 1822; d. March 14, 1823.
- 1672 III. Abram H., b. Dec. 24, 1824; m. 1st, Elizabeth A. Underhill, April 8, 1848; she d. March 20, 1882; he m. 2d, Metta Drake Barton, Feb. 19, 1885. He was a builder and trimmer, doing the ornamental woodwork in several of the finest hotels in New York, in the residence of A. T. Stewart, and other expensive houses. He is now retired, and lives at Rutherford, N. J.
- 1673 IV. Catharine M., b. Jan. 20, 1827; m. Cornelius Williamson Creed, Sept. 28, 1856; he was b. at Neshanic, N. J., Aug. 12, 1830; d. March 10, 1895, and is buried beside his two daughters in the Creed family burying ground at Bound Brook, N. J. They lived for two years at Bound Brook, then for two years in New York city; in 1860 they removed to Pelham, where he was postmaster, 1861–88. Issue:
