He was graduated from Rutgers College, in the Class of 1862, and from the New Brunswick Theological Seminary in 1865. He was licensed by the Classis of Passaic in June, 1865, and began preaching in the Presbyterian church at Swartswood in October, 1865, where he labored with such acceptance that he was called to the pastorate of that church, and having been transferred by certificate from the Classis of Passaic to the Presbytery of Newton, was ordained by that Presbytery in April, 1866. In October, 1867, he became pastor of the Second Mansfield Presbyterian Church, Stephensburg, N. J., whence he removed, in July, 1872, to the Presbytery of Lackawanna, Penn., taking charge of the churches at Upsonville and Liberty. In November, 1877, he removed to Summit Hill, Pa., and in December, 1892, to the Presbyterian church at Middagh's, Penn., his present charge (December, 1896).
