Cornelis (85)--Cornelis--Johannes--Cornelis Doremus was b. Oct. 10, 1767; m. 1st, Mary (?) Speer, who d. about a year later; 2d, Catharine (b. Aug. 23, 1769, sister of Garret) Miller; he d. June 10, 1817, and was buried in an old burying ground at Parsippany, on property now owned by James Kingsland; no trace of the burying ground remains; she d.
