Feb. 5, 1798; m. 1st, Peggy Reemer,¹ Nov. 28, 1819, at Preakness; she d. in Newark; he m. 2d, Anna Maria Knighton (dau. of Thomas Knighton and Ann Stephens, of Morristown), in Newark, about 1845; d. Nov. 22, 1875, in Paterson; she d. Oct. 28, 1889, in Paterson, aged 66 yrs. He was a hatter on Broad street, near the canal, in Newark; his first wife kept a millinery store in the same building. About 1846 he removed to Paterson, where he worked at hat-pressing, then kept a green-grocery, and later was employed in the Rogers Locomotive works. He had children:
