(Jonathan D'o 3d of Tolland 1722 Town records there give m. as 1754 which seems conclusive that ceremony was there We find that b. m. & d.'s were duplicated as shown by fathers fam records of which 8 were b Dartmouth & 5 Tolland When Jonathan 2d became town clerk of do. he placed births of his entire fam on the books. Waldo in Hist of Tolland says 9 were b Dartmouth, which prob is correct. Also gives J. 3d m A Ladd & 7 ch as b in Tol. 2, Marg't & Hibbard not mentioned although H. (the compilers gr father) often asserted he was born there 26 Aug '76. In searching different town records we find in Coventry births of Anna & Philip as shown, which the compiler believes correct, also his m must have occurred at Coventry though the records there do not show it. Many of the D'os of Tol. then and earlier (1762) moved to the western part of the state, settling Litchfield Co. and others Dutchess Co. N. Y. on disputed territory between Conn & N. Y. called the "Oblong." From records in Rev Knibloes Ch at Amenia Dutchess Co are found these entries (The births are not given, only hapt) "Esth. bapt Nov 4-1764 b as shown, Zeb. bapt July 12-1767, b etc Chlor. bapt Aug 13-1769, b etc" Jon. 3d prob. lived & the 3 ch have been b there then m back to Tolland where last 2 were b. When Rev War began 3 eldest sons responded "Conn in Rev War" 8th Regt. Col Huntington 1775 Recruited mainly in New London, Hartford & Winsor. Stationed on the Sound until Sept 4th, ordered to Bos. Camps, post at Roxbury Genl Spencers Brigade, remained until discharged. Dec 17-1775. Jabez & Jonathan 4th enlisted July 9th disch Dec 17-1775 Mem. 9 co. The Regt re-organized by Col Huntington 1776, of Norwich "Do" p. 400. Capt Birges Co. 3d Batallion, Col Comfort Sage. Wadsworth Brigade 1776 of Middletown, Jabez, Jonathan 4th & Philip are mentioned, 3 bros. Jonathan p. 233. Paul Brigham's Co. 8th Regt. Col John Chandler, enlisted June 9-1777 3 yr. corporal Jan 10-1778. Philip p. 533. Enlisted Aug 5-1778, disch Sept 21-1778 was at battle of Newport R. I. Aug 29-1778, Capt
