

Chaplain Hedley Heber Cooper, 71st Infantry, Walkersville, Ontario. Killed while acting as stretcher bearer.




Captain Frank P. Hulett, 2d Engineers, Lewiston, Me. Killed in action.

Private Floyd Evans, U. S. M. C., 6th Regiment, Hamilton, N. Y. Killed in action.




Lieutenant Howard L. Smith, F. R. A. C., Company A, Military Police, Oshkosh, Wis. Killed in action.

Private Louis De Palma, 9th Infantry, Newark, N. J. Killed in action.




Private Arthur L. Simrell, 25d Infantry, Babylon, N. Y. Died from wounds received in action.
