In 1871-8 the theatre was reconstructed and housed the theatre of Hengler's Circus.

The present theatre was completed in 1901 and named The London Palladium. It has had the great names of the theatre. Later became a variety theatre but reverted to variety theatre in September, 1955.

The present theatre was inaugurated in 1948, has established the London Palladium as the World Music Hall.
