Senor Wences, who opens an engagement at \_\_\_\_\_ on \_\_\_\_\_ is truly one of the most sensational entertainers in show business today. He ranges far-afield from the conventional method of most ventriloquists. Instead of using the normal wooden dummy, Senor Wences draws a face on his clenched fist, and by manipulating fingers and muscles gets an effect that is a great characterization of what Wences calls "Johnny." The hand is supplemented by eyes, lipstick, wig and an ordinary doll's body. Among other things "Johnny" smokes a cigarette. Wences "throws" eleven different voices and is also one of the stage's best jugglers. On top of all this, he has an amazing sense of "comedy timing" which makes his act a constant show-stopper.

Born in Salamanca, Spain, Wences was a torero in native bull-rings. Since switching to the comparatively placid art of ventriloquy, Senor Wences has played all over the world, including Europe's famed Palladium, the renowned Copacabana Casino in Rio De Janeiro, and all of the leading theaters and night clubs in the United States. He has toured America with the "Danny Kaye International Revue," and was featured in 20th Century Fox's "Mother Wore Tights," where his act was reproduced exactly and ran on screen for the entire eight minutes. He has been starred on television many times and has been featured quite often on Ed Sullivan's "Toast of the Town."
