



THE BOSTON SYMPHONY PENSION INSTITUTION

The Boston Symphony Pension Institution, established in 1903, is the oldest among American symphony orchestras and probably the most generous. During the past few years the Pension Institution has paid annually about a quarter of a million dollars to nearly one hundred pensioners and their widows. Institution income is derived from Pension Fund concerts, open rehearsals in Symphony Hall and at Tanglewood, radio broadcasts, as well as members' dues, matching contributions from the Boston Symphony Orchestra Incorporated, and invested funds.
