1. FRONT LINE: See Map.

BOUNDARY CHANGES:

Boundary between VI Corps and XXI Corps: From boundary between 6th Army Group and 12th Army Group vicinity X7533 - thence northeast along east boundary LANDKREIS BIBERACH X6050 - north boundary LANDKREIS MEMMINGEN X8535 - north boundary LANDKREIS MIMDELHEIM Y1045 - north boundary LANDKREIS SCHWAEMUNCHEN Y2560 - west boundary LANDKREIS FRIEDBERG Y4575 to boundary between Seventh Army and Third Army vicinity Y3489.

Boundary between XII Corps and XX Corps changed as follows: From DANUBE River vicinity U1148 - thence south along west boundary LANDKREIS REGENSBURG U2555 - west boundary LANDKREIS MALLERSDORF U3030 - west boundary LANDKREIS DINGOLFING U5015 - west boundary LANDKREIS EGGENFELDEN U7000 - south boundary LANDKREIS PFARRKIRCHEN Z8590 - east boundary LANDKREIS GRIESBACH V1090 - east boundary LANDKREIS PASSAU Q2020 to DANUBE River vicinity Q2313 - thence east along DANUBE River as before.

Boundary between V and XII Corps: From vicinity P2472 - south along Czechoslovakian border to vicinity Q9321.

3. ADJACENT UNITS AND SUPPORTING TROOPS.

6TH ARMY GROUP. (271200B). FIRST FRENCH ARMY. (Army Troops). GROUPMENT de CLERCK and 1st French Armored Division (with 9th Regt de Chasseurs Algeriens atchd). No change.

II and I French Corps. No change.

21 ARMY GROUP. (271200B). I British Corps District. 49th British Division. (With 1st Cdn Armd Bde atchd). The 147th Brigade concentrated in the vicinity of W4100 - W4101 - W4505.

SECOND BRITISH ARMY. (Army Troops). 8th US Division, 6th British Airborne Division and 82d US Airborne Division. All no change.

VIII and XII British Corps. No change.

XXX Corps. 51st Division. The 153d Brigade relieved the 305th Anti-Aircraft Brigade and assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS NEUSTADT X2040, LANDKREIS NIENBURG W9040 and LANDKREIS DIEPHOLZ W6050.

FIRST CANADIAN ARMY. (Army Troops). 5th Canadian Armored Division (with 18th Cdn Armd Car Regt atchd), 1st Canadian Infantry Brigade Group and 2d Canadian Armored Brigade. All no change. 4th Canadian Armored Division. See II Canadian Corps.

II Canadian Corps. 4th Canadian Armored Division. The 4th Canadian Armored Brigade closed in a division assembly area in the vicinity of ALMELO V2718. The division was relieved from attachment to II Canadian Corps and placed under army command. 2d Canadian Division. (With 301st Br Inf Bde atchd). One battalion of the 5th Canadian Infantry Brigade concentrated in the vicinity of R2031 and another battalion concentrated in the vicinity of R2633.

I Canadian Corps. No change.

AIR. (27 May). No operations.

4. WEATHER (Germany).

Precipitation: Intermittent rain and showers. Clouds: Broken to overcast. Visibility: 3 - 5 miles at dawn, becoming more than 6 miles during the afternoon, except in rain and showers where limited to 2 miles. Wind: 5 mph, south. Temperatures at WIESEADEN: Maximum 60° F. Minimum 50° F.

5. OUR OPERATIONS.

12TH ARMY GROUP. SEVENTH ARMY. Disarmament of enemy personnel in army zone completed, except that prisoners of war have one rifle per 100 men and one pistol per officer for guard purposes. Horse drawn transport of German Nineteenth Army continued movement to LANDKREIS WOLFRATSHAUSEN Y8030.

XXI Corps. 86th Division. Advance detachment commenced movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of LE HAVRE L5027.

VI Corps. Corps artillery occupied and assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS STARNBERG Y6240, LANDKREIS WOLFRATSHAUSEN Y8030, LANDKREIS EBERSBERG Z1050 and LANDKREIS AIBLING Z2030. The 35th Anti-Aircraft Artillery Brigade occupied and assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS FUSSEN D2095 and that portion of LANDKREIS SONTHOFFEN C8580 in Seventh Army zone. 2d French Armored Division. Continued movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of METZ U8757.

THIRD ARMY. XV Corps. 42d Division. Units in Seventh Army zone relieved by VI Corps artillery.

XX Corps. No change.

XII Corps. Corps artillery occupied and assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS REGENSBURG U2555, LANDKREIS STRAUBING U5540, LANDKREIS BOGEN U6555, LANDKREIS RADING U4075, LANDKREIS CHAM U6080 and LANDKREIS VIECHTACH U8060. 4th Armored Division. Continued movement to the vicinity of LANDSHUT U2503 - NEUMARKT T7182. 26th Division. Attached to V Corps at 281200B.

V and III Corps. No change.

NINTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 2d Armored Division and 29th Division. No change.

VIII Corps. 87th Division. See 30th Division. 89th Division. The 354th Infantry continued movement to the vicinity of DEAUVILLE, FRANCE I4513.

VII Corps. No change.

XIII Corps. Corps artillery commenced to be relieved by the 43d British Division. 30th Division. The 117th Infantry relieved the 347th Infantry (87th Div) in LANDKREIS OELSNITZ K1807 and assumed responsibility for the area. The 52d British Division continued to relieve units of the 30th Division. 102d Division. Units of the 52d British Division relieved the 405th Infantry and the 407th Infantry in LANDKREIS OSTERBURG Y7080 and LANDKREIS STENDAL Y7550 and assumed responsibility for the area. The 155th British Infantry Brigade commenced to relieve the division artillery. Units of the 102d Division continued movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of GOTHA J0866.

XIX Corps. No change.

XVI Corps. 35th Division. The 134th Infantry continued movement to the vicinity of KOBLENZ L9094.

FIFTEENTH ARMY. XXIII Corps. 66th Division. Closed in REGIERUNGS BEZIRKE KOBLENZ at 271755B. Units continued movement to the vicinity of MARSEILLES T4715.

XXII Corps. No change.
