6TH ARMY GROUP. (311200B May). FIRST FRENCH ARMY. (Army Troops). GROUPMENT de CLERCK and 1st French Armored Division (with 9th Regt de Chasseurs Algeriens atchd). No change. 10th French Division. (With 1st Regt de SPAHI Moroccans atchd). Continued movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of STRASSEBURG W0198.

II and I French Corps. No change.

21 ARMY GROUP. (311200B May). I British Corps District. 3d British Division. (With 9th Army Gp Royal Arty, 34th Belgian Bde and 1st Belgian Bde atchd). The 34th Armored Brigade continued movement to LANDKREIS LUDINGHAUSEN A8552, LANDKREIS BECKUM B2052 and LANDKREIS TECKLENBURG W0005. Units of the 9th Infantry Brigade occupied the areas A7735 and A4325 - A5331 - A4642. The 9th Army Group Royal Artillery continued to occupy LANDKREIS COESFELD A6075. The 1st Belgian Brigade concentrated in the areas in the vicinity of B0662, A7484 and B3549.

SECOND BRITISH ARMY. (Army Troops). 8th US Division, 6th British Airborne Division and 82d US Airborne Division. All no change.

VIII British Corps. 7th British Armored Division. Units occupied the areas in the vicinity of S1178 and W0916.

XII British Corps. No change.

XXX Corps. 305th Anti-Aircraft Brigade. Units occupied LANDKREIS LINGEN V7530, LANDKREIS BERSENBRUCK W1032, LANDKREIS WITTLAGE W3820, LANDKREIS MELLE W4200 and LANDKREIS OSNABRUCK W2500. 105th Anti-Aircraft Brigade. Units occupied LANDKREIS PEINE X6915, LANDKREIS HILDESHEIM X5003 and LANDKREIS MARIENBURG C6286 and commenced to occupy LANDKREIS OSTERODE C7442 and LANDKREIS DUDERSTADT C7230. Guards Armored Division. (With 1st Household Cav Regt atchd). Units concentrated in the areas in the vicinity of W8186 and S0027.

FIRST CANADIAN ARMY. (Army Troops). 5th Canadian Armored Division (with 18th Cdn Armd Cav Regt atchd), 1st Canadian Infantry Brigade Group, 2d Canadian Armored Brigade and 4th Canadian Armored Division. All no change.

II and I Canadian Corps. No change.

AIR. (31 May). No operations.

4. WEATHER (Germany).

Precipitation: Scattered showers. Clouds: Scattered to broken. Visibility: 2 - 3 miles at dawn, becoming more than 5 miles by 1100B, except in showers where limited to 2 miles. Wind: Light and variable. Temperatures at WIESBADEN: Maximum 80° F. Minimum 50° F.

12TH ARMY GROUP. SEVENTH ARMY. Horse drawn transport of German Nineteenth Army continued movement to LANDKREIS WOLFRATSHAUSEN Y8030. German Second Panzer Army continued movement to LANDKREIS WEILHEIM Y6015.

VI Corps. No change.

XXI Corps. 86th Division. Continued movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of LE HAVRE L5027.

THIRD ARMY. XV Corps. 20th Armored Division. Units of XX Corps relieved units of 20th Armored Division in LANDKREIS BRAUNAU V0065 and LANDKREIS VOCKLABRUCK V3545 and assumed responsibility for the area.

XX Corps. No change.

XII Corps. 4th Armored Division. Relieved units of III Corps and XX Corps in new sector and assumed responsibility for the area.

V Corps. Czechoslovakian Armored Brigade. Units which participated in PRAGUE L7887 parade rejoined command.

III Corps. 97th Division. Cleared Third Army area enroute to an assembly area in the vicinity of LE HAVRE L5027.

NINTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 2d Armored Division and 29th Division. No change.

VIII Corps. Corps artillery relieved units of 102d Division in LANDKREIS ZELLA-MEBLIS JO734 and assumed responsibility for the area. 89th Division. Units continued movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of LE HAVRE L5027.

VII Corps. No change.

XIII Corps. 83d Division. Units of XXX British Corps relieved the 330th Infantry Regiment in LANDKREIS GOSLAR C8580 and assumed responsibility for the area. 84th Division. Continued to be relieved by units of XXX British Corps.

XIX Corps. No change.

XVI Corps. Corps artillery relieved of responsibility for LANDKREIS HALLE B4085 by units of I British Corps District. 35th Division. Relieved of responsibility for LANDKREIS RECKLINGHAUSEN A5040, STADTKREIS RECKLINGHAUSEN A6334, STADTKREIS BOTTROP A4325, STADTKREIS GLADBECK A4631, STADTKREIS GELSENKIRCHEN A5328, LANDKREIS MUNSTER A9070, STADTKREIS MUNSTER A9273, LANDKREIS WARENDORF B2075, LANDKREIS LUDINGHAUSEN A8050 and commenced to be relieved in LANDKREIS COESFELD A6070 by units of I British Corps District. The 137th Infantry Regiment and elements of 35th Division Artillery commenced movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of KOBLENZ L9094. 79th Division. Elements of Special Troops commenced movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of EGER P3174.
