BOUNDARY CHANGE:

Boundary change between 6th Army Group and 12th Army Group (effective 101200B):  
As before to the vicinity of M5010 - thence north along the RHINE River to the  
vicinity of M0362 - eastern boundary of LANDKREIS SANKT GOARSHAUSEN M0075 to the  
vicinity of M1579 - eastern boundary of LANDKREIS UNTERLAHN M1090 to the vicinity  
of G1800 - eastern boundary of LANDKREIS UNTER ESTERWALD G0505 to the vicinity of  
G1808 - southern, western and northern boundary of LANDKREIS OBERESTERWALD G1520  
to the boundary between 12th Army Group and 21 Army Group in the vicinity of G2133.

3. ADJACENT UNITS AND SUPPORTING TROOPS.

6TH ARMY GROUP. (091200B). FIRST FRENCH ARMY. (Army Troops). Groupment de Clerck. No change.

II French Corps. 1st French Armored Division. Commenced to relieve United States forces in REGIERUNGSBEZIRKE TRIER and KOBLENZ. 1st French Division. Continued to relieve United States forces in SAARLAND (REICHSGAU WESTMARK). 3d Algerian Division. Commenced to relieve United States forces in that portion of LAND HESSEN (South) west of the RHINE River. 9th Colonial Division. Relieved from attachment to II French Corps and reverted to command First French Army. 10th French Division. Commenced to relieve United States forces in REGIERUNGSBEZIRKE TRIER and KOBLENZ and the northwestern portion of PROVINZ NASSAU. 14th French Division. Attached to South French Corps.

South French Corps. 2d Moroccan Division. Commenced to close in new occupational area in LAND BADEN and relieved of responsibility for LANDKREISE MEMPINGEN X9030, KEMPTEN X9005 and SONTHOFEN C9080 by units of XX Corps (Third Army).

I French Corps. 4th Moroccan Mountain Division. Continued to relieve United States forces in REICHSGAU TIROL - VORARLBERG.

21 ARMY GROUP. (091200B). I British Corps District. 19th Line of Communication Sub Area. Assumed responsibility for LANDKREISE BORKEN A4060, COESFELD A6070, ARHEUS A6085, MUNSTER A9580, STEINFURT A7595 and TECKLENBURG W0010, and STADTKREISE BOCHOLT A2362 and MUNSTER A9075 at 081200B.

XXX British Corps District. 2d Canadian Division. Relieved from attachment and reverted to command First Canadian Army at 090800B.

VIII British Corps District. 7th British Armored Division. Assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS PINNEBERG S3570.

SECOND BRITISH ARMY HEADQUARTERS. No change.

FIRST CANADIAN ARMY. (Army Troops). 4th Canadian Armored Division, 5th Canadian Armored Division (with 18th Cdn Arm'd Car Regt atchd) and 2d Canadian Armored Brigade. All no change.

I Canadian Corps. 3d Canadian Division. Attached to XXX British Corps District and assumed responsibility for 2d Canadian Division area at 090800B.

4. WEATHER (Germany).

Precipitation: Light rain. Clouds: Broken to overcast. Visibility: 3 - 8 miles at dawn becoming more than 6 miles by 1000B except in showers where limited to 1 - 2 miles. Wind: South, 5 mph. Temperatures at WIESBADEN: Maximum 80° F. Minimum 52° F.

## 5. OUR OPERATIONS.

12TH ARMY GROUP. (Army Group Troops). Ninth Army Headquarters, Headquarters Company and Special Troops. Continued movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of DEAUVILLE L4413.

SEVENTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 29th Division. Major General CHARLES H. GERHARDT 05259 assumed command on 5 July, vice Brigadier General WILLIAM H. SANDS 0174202, relieved.

VI Corps. No change.

XIX Corps. 3d Division. Continued to close in the vicinity of KASSEL G2204. 70th Division. (With 15th Cav Gp atchd). Relieved by units of the II French Corps in LANDKREISE UNTERWESSTERWALD G0505, UNTERLAHN M1090 and SANKT GOARSHAUSEN MO075 at 101200B. Continued to be relieved by units of the II French Corps in LANDKREIS OBERWESSTERWALD G1520.

XXI Corps. No change.

VIII Corps. Headquarters, Headquarters Company and Corps Artillery Headquarters Headquarters Battery. Cleared army area at 101200B enroute to an assembly area in the vicinity of LE HAVRE L5027. Relieved from assignment to Seventh Army and 12th Army Group and reverted to command USFET.

THIRD ARMY. (Army Troops). Headquarters, Headquarters Company II Corps, 11th Armored Division, 42d Division and 65th Division. All relieved from assignment to Third Army and 12th Army Group and assigned to USOFA and attached to Third Army for supply on 6 July.

XX Corps. 20th Armored Division. The Advance Party closed in an assembly area in the vicinity of LE HAVRE L5027. Division commenced movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of REIMS T3180. 103d Division (II Corps USOFA). Relieved of responsibility for occupational area in REICHSGAU TIROL - VORARLBERG by 4th Moroccan Mountain Division at 091500B. Closed in XX Corps zone and reverted to command of Third Army and attached to XX Corps on 10 July.

XII Corps. 102d Division. Continued to close in 83d Division sector in the vicinity of VILSHOFEN Q0119.

XXII Corps. No change.

XV Corps. 6th Armored Division. Relieved units of 99th Division in and assumed responsibility for LANDKREISE MILTENBERG N1020, OBERNBURG N0540, ASCHAFFENBURG N0550 and ALZENAU N0565 at 100001B.

FIFTEENTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 106th Division. (With 159th Inf atchd). Assigned to Seventh Army at 101200B.

XXIII Corps. Corps Headquarters and Headquarters Company. Assigned to Seventh Army at 101200B. Corps Artillery. Relieved by units of the II French Corps in SAARLAND and LAND KREISEN (South) west of the RHINE River and assigned to Seventh Army at 101200B. 35th Division (less 137th Inf) and 426th Field Artillery Group. Relieved by units of II French Corps in REGIERUNGSBEZIRKE TRIER and KOBLENZ at 101200B and relieved from attachment to XXIII Corps. 137th Infantry. Continued movement to ANTWERP J6397.
