6TH ARMY GROUP. (121200B). FIRST FRENCH ARMY. (Army Troops). 9th Colonial Division and Groupment de Clerck. No change.

I French Corps and South French Corps. No change.

II French Corps. 10th French Division. Relieved units of 70th Division (XIX Corps) in LANDKREIS OBERWESTERWALD G1520 and assumed responsibility for the area.

21 ARMY GROUP. (111200B). I, XXX and VIII British Corps Districts. All no change.

SECOND BRITISH ARMY HEADQUARTERS. No change.

FIRST CANADIAN ARMY. (Army Troops). 4th Canadian Armored Division, 5th Canadian Armored Division (with 18th Cdn Armd Car Regt atchd), 2d Canadian Division and 2d Canadian Armored Brigade. All no change.

I Canadian Corps. No change.

4. WEATHER (Germany).

Precipitation: None. Clouds: Small amounts of low clouds at dawn, becoming scattered by 1200B. Visibility: 2 - 3 miles at dawn, becoming over 5 miles by 1100B. Wind: Light and variable. Temperatures at WIESEBADEN: Maximum 80° F. Minimum 57° F.

5. OUR OPERATIONS.

12TH ARMY GROUP. (Army Group Troops). Ninth Army Headquarters, Headquarters Company and Special Troops. No change.

SEVENTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 29th Division. No change. 106th Division. (With 159th Inf atchd). Continued movement to an assembly area in LANDKREIS BRUCHSAL R6065. The division (with attachment) was attached to VI Corps.

VI Corps. No change.

XIX Corps. 3d Division. Continued to close and relieve units of the 78th Division in PROVINZ KURHESSEN. 78th Division. Commenced to close in LANDKREIS HOFGEISMAR C2020.

XXI and XXIII Corps. No change.

THIRD ARMY. XX Corps. Major General RAY B. PRICETT 04458 assumed command of XX Corps on 8 July, vice Major General LEWIS A. CRAIG 03575, on Detached Service. 20th Armored Division. Continued movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of LE HAVRE L5027

XII Corps. 4th Armored Division. Brigadier General BRUCE C. CLARK 016068 assumed command 4th Armored Division on 21 June, vice Brigadier General WILLIAM L. ROBERTS 03597, relieved; Brigadier General WILLIAM L. ROBERTS 03597 assumed command on 5 July, vice Brigadier General BRUCE C. CLARK 016068, relieved.

FIFTEENTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 137th Infantry Regiment (35th Div). No change. 35th Division. (Less 137th Inf). Cleared the army zone enroute to an assembly area in the vicinity of REIMS T3180. The division was relieved from assignment to 12th Army Group and reverted to command USTET. 16th Cavalry Group. Assigned to Third Army on 15 June. Relieved from attachment for operations only to I British Corps District on 22 June. Closed in an assembly area in the vicinity of COBURG 03090 at 121730B July. The group was attached to XV Corps.
