THIRD ARMY. XX Corps. 45th Division. Cleared the army area, enroute to an assembly area in the vicinity of REIMS T3180. Relieved from assignment to 12th Army Group and reverted command USFET.

XXII Corps. 26th Division. Continued to close in XV Corps area in the vicinity of HAMMELBURG N5470. Was attached to XV Corps at 211800B. 94th Division. Completed the relief of 26th Division and assumed responsibility for the area at 211800B.
