1. FRONT LINE: Not applicable.

BOUNDARY CHANGE:

Boundary change between Soviet forces and 21 Army Group: As before to the road junction in the vicinity of C9333 - thence east along south side of road to TETTENBORN C9534 and NEUHOF C9735 - thence east as before along northern boundary of LANDKREIS HOHENSTEIN D0525 to stream in the vicinity of D0348 - north along stream to northern boundary of LANDKREIS BLANKENBURG D2050 in the vicinity of D0349 - thence northwest as before along western boundary of PROVINZ MAGDEBURG.

Relieved by and passed responsibility to Soviet forces in that portion of LANDKREIS BLANKENBURG D2050 east of stream D0348 - D0349 at 231400B.
