Summary: Continental congressman, United States senator from South Carolina, diplomat. Correspondence and miscellaneous material concerning the Izard family regarding domestic life and social affairs in Charleston, South Carolina, and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and including the involvement of family members in managing their estate in South Carolina and the Tripolitan War.

1767	Married Alice DeLancy (died 1832)
1771-1776	Resided in London, England, and Paris, France
1776-1779	Served as commissioner to the Court of Tuscany for the Continental Congress
1780	Pledged his estate in South Carolina for the payment of warships to be used in the American Revolution
1782-1783	Member, Continental Congress
1789-1796	Served in United States Senate; president pro tempore of the senate
1804, May 30	Died, near Charleston, S.C.

Scope and Content Note

The Ralph Izard Family Papers span the years 1778-1826, with the bulk of the material dating from 1801-1814. The correspondence includes letters of Ralph Izard (1742-1804) relating to his Charleston, South Carolina, estate and the education of his son George Izard (1777-1828); letters of his son, Ralph Izard (1785-1824), relating in part to his service with the United States Navy during the Tripolitan War; and the letters of Alice DeLancey Izard (1745-1832), Margaret Izard Manigault (1768-1824), and Elizabeth Middleton Izard (1787-1822) relating to family and domestic life and to social

affairs in Charleston, South Carolina, and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Other correspondents include Thomas Pinckney and John Parker.
