Solid copper tubs, large enough to wash ten sheets or fourteen pounds of dry clothes at one washing.

There are no corners or crevices to retain impurities and dirty suds. Easy to operate. Easy to keep clean.

Electric motor and driving mechanism are underneath the tub—compact and out of the way. Occupies little space. Easily moved about.

A gas heater which we furnish extra at small cost can be attached under the tub to heat the water or maintain any desired temperature.

Wringer can be swung in any convenient position, is electrically driven and operates forward or reverse. One simple lever controls it. Drive gears and shaft enclosed in oil-tight case.

Substantially constructed of solid copper, brass, steel and iron.
