- WA-14-42: View forward on afterdeck, showing steering gear box in foreground, aft elevation of cabin beyond; weather canopy overhead is not an original or permanent feature
- WA-14-43: View toward port quarter on afterdeck showing steering box and taffrail
- WA-14-44: 'Tween deck, view looking forward into crew's quarters in forecastle
- WA-14-45: Interior of hold, view aft down port side from position near foremast
- WA-14-46: Interior of hold, view forward on port side from point near mizzenmast
- WA-14-47: Interior of hold, detail of port side of mizzenmast step and deck stanchions
- WA-14-48: Interior of hold amidship, looking forward at port side

- WA-14-52: View from Valley Street toward vessel at berth on October 9, 1986, a few minutes prior to towing to Lake Union Dry Dock Company for lines-lifting project
- WA-14-53: October 9, 1985: tugboat preparing to move WAWONA to Lake Union Dry Dock Company for lines-lifting project
- WA-14-54: October 9, 1985: WAWONA under tow to Lake Union Dry Dock Company, as seen from Valley Street
- WA-14-55: October 9, 1985: preparing to move WAWONA into Dry Dock No. 7 at Lake Union Dry Dock Company (dry dock submerged for operation)
- WA-15-56: October 9, 1985: tugboats moving WAWONA toward submerged dry dock
- WA-14-57: October 9, 1985: vessel entering submerged dry dock
- WA-14-58: October 9, 1985: docking operation in progress under direction of dockmaster on barge in foreground; diver (next to dinghy filled with wooden wedges) preparing to assist in positioning vessel over keel blocks
- WA-14-59: October 9, 1985: dry dock being raised after vessel has been positioned over keel and haul blocks
- WA-14-60: October 9, 1985: vessel out of water as dry dock continues to rise
- WA-14-61: October 9, 1985: dry dock deck beginning to emerge as dock is raised
- WA-14-62: October 9, 1985: dry dock crew inspects dock, blocks, and vessel after completion of docking operation
