

## Letter from Alexander Melville Bell to Alexander Graham Bell, April 30, 1877, with transcript

Tutelo Heights, Brantford, Ont., Can., April 30th, 77. (No envelope) My dear Al.,

If you carry out your intended tour in the old country I should recommend you to take with you as business manager, Mr. Henderson. He knows the ground and the work, and he is willing to undertake it. With dual lectures you cannot possibly dispense with a business Agent on whom you can rely. If you wish to secure Mr. H'S services write him without delay to the address, Box 16 Brantford. He could join you at once, for your U. S. tour also if you wish. Love to self and Mabel.
