ALEXANDER GRAHAM BELL TO MABEL (Hubbard) BELL Parker House, Boston.
Thursday, Nov. 8, 1894. Dear Mabel:

Have just finished a busy day at Horace Mann School. Met Mr. Thomson, Chairman of Parents Committee, and went over proposed constitution and etc., — with him and Miss Fuller. Adjourned to dinner at Parker House — and meeting continued till now, 9:30 P.M. Think a most important organization is about to be born vig:
