Two nice young fellows friends of Baldwin Broke Journey south to see him here one of them fell on skating rink Wednesday and dislocated leg at knee Doctor says he is all right but must rest for few days. They will not remain here probably on account of expense and will go on to Washington tomorrow friday same train with us would like to have them stay with us if you approve telegraph invitation to Baldwin. Have said nothing to him myself. We leave afternoon about four thirty would give them annex and send Baldwin up stairs.
