Letter from Mrs. Alexander Graham Bell to Dr. Alexander Graham Bell. 1331 Connecticut Avenue, Washington, D. C. April 10, 1909. Dear Alec:

This is Easter Sunday and a bright fresh one and all Washington is out in fresh clothes to match the freshness of the earth. Daisy and I have been through the zoo which was crowded, and all around were beautiful trees in bloom. It is lovely here now and I wish you were here.

Elsie and Bert received the Literary Society last night. It was their first big party and they were quite flustered and excited. Charles ran it for them and it went off very well and there was none of the crowding they dreaded. I went over and every one was very nice to me.

I am busy now getting out their cards for the 21st. I calculate that this has a bare chance of reaching you and so send it with a lot of love and welcome home.
