Cambria, Wisconsin is considered the most typically Welsh [towns?] in Wisconsin. When it was first settled it was almost one hundred per cent Welsh and today it is over seventy-five per cent Welsh

The Welsh dominate the village, it being much more common to hear Welsh on the Main Street and in the stores than it is to hear English.

Cambria is another name for the Cymru (the Welsh). The people who come from Wales, say that they feel perfectly at home in Cambria, Wisconsin.
