Agreement

between

Mr. Ragheb Muftah, of Rue Foad el Awal, Cairo

and

Professor Ernest Newlandsmith,

Pax, Letchworth, England.

Professor Newlandsmith agrees to compile a book on Ancient Egyptian Music and Mr. Muftah (on behalf of the Committee of the Music of the Coptic Church) agrees:--

1. To pay Professor Newlandsmith £30 (Egyptian) each month (in advance) during the period in which he is engaged in compiling the aforesaid book.
2. To pay Professor Newlandsmith a "Royalty" of 15% on each copy of the book when published.
3. That should it be necessary for Professor Newlandsmith to go to England before he begins the work (if possible not delaying the beginning of the work later than October next) that Mr. Muftah will pay his return fare (single cabin) between London and Cairo.

4. To arrange so that such singers and interpreters are supplied as will facilitate the compilation of the book as rapidly as is consistent with sound work: the time for compilation in no case exceeding three months during which time Professor Newlandsmith's main occupation will be the compilation of this book of Coptic Music, but he is free to accept musical engagements which do not interfere with this work.
