DANNY KAYE TO JOIN WITH LOS ANGELES PHILHARMONIC
FOR SPECIAL PENSION FUND CONCERT AT HOLLYWOOD BOWL
SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 8

Danny Kaye, one of the legendary personalities in the entertainment world and a symphony orchestra conductor extraordinaire, will join with members of the Los Angeles Philharmonic for a special Pension Fund Concert at Hollywood Bowl Sunday, September 8 at 7:00 p.m.

The evening will open with an overture led by the conductor in residence at the Bowl that week, Sir Charles Groves. Groves will then pass the baton to Maestro Kaye, who will proceed to regale the audience and the musicians with his inspired, inimitable podium antics, as well as to demonstrate his quite remarkable, critically acknowledged abilities as a conductor. Kaye has been conducting symphony orchestras in the U.S. and abroad for more than 25 years, largely for the benefit of musicians' pension funds, raising more than \$6 million without ever accepting a fee for his services.

DANNY KAYE is unique among show business celebrities. The versatile entertainer has starred on Broadway, in motion pictures, on radio and television; he is a successful recording artist, an acclaimed conductor of symphony orchestras the world over, and a record-breaking supper-club headliner. In addition, he is a serious and concerned student of world affairs, and has been serving as the international Ambassador-at-Large for UNICEF for the past 31 years. He has been the recipient of numerous awards and citations for his

work as both artist and humanitarian; most recently, in December 1984, he was one of five artists to receive the prestigious Kennedy Center Honors for lifetime achievement in the arts at ceremonies in Washington, D.C.
