Harry may have told you that I have resigned my post,* effective the end of the Tanglewood season 1966, and will thereafter make my home in Carmel Highlands, 450 feet above the sea, from which I will journey to lecture, here and there throughout the country, and to fill occasional other professional engagements. I want to be as little involved as possible because I want to devote myself largely to a book which I want to do and to numberless other activities, particularly photographing.

I am working hard on getting Harry to change the direction of his life and move out to our area in California. Therefore, I expect only support from you in getting behind him to give a really good push which is going to make Harry and Jane decide that the place to live is somewhere on the West Coast. So try your damndest, man.

I look forward to seeing you when we are there. Meanwhile I continue to hope that we will have another concert with you while I am in the orchestra.
