This is to confirm that we have accepted your application as an Engineer in our settlement in Santo Domingo.

In accordance with our agreement with the Dominican Government entered into in January 1940, we have the right to bring into Santo Domingo settlers for our colonization project, as well as a staff of engineers, agriculturalists, etc.

We have applied for a visa for you, your wife and child, but it will naturally take some time before we can have the proper arrangements for your visa, we will advise you to the effect that you can make arrangements for your departure. Your visa will be sent to a Dominican Consul in Italy, whom you may designate.
