





4. March! March! March! our help art Thou, Je-ho-vah, Lead us on to vic-to-ry;





This the hour of conquest of the na-tions, Burns this truth in liv-ing lines.

Take Thy scap-tre now and rule the na-tions, In e-ter-nal ma-jes-ty.







O, that day of vic-to-ry, when in won-drous ma-jes-ty
