**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE ADVOCATE.

**Response.**—My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an *Advocate* with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.—1 John 2:1.

ALPHA AND OMEGA, THE LORD, THE ALMIGHTY.

I am *Alpha* and *Omega*, the beginning and the end, saith the *Lord*, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the *Almighty*.—Rev. 1:8.

THE AMEN, THE FAITHFUL AND TRUE WITNESS, THE BEGINNING  
OF THE CREATION OF GOD.

And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith *The Amen, The Faithful and True Witness, The Beginning of the Creation of God*.—Rev. 3:14.

THE APOSTLE AND HIGH PRIEST.

Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the *Apostle* and *High Priest* of our profession, Christ Jesus.—Heb. 3:1.

THE BELOVED SON.

And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water; and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him. And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my *Beloved Son*, in whom I am well pleased.—Matt. 3:16, 17.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE BREAD OF LIFE.

**Response.**—And Jesus said unto them, I am the *Bread of Life*; he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.—John 6:35.

THE BRIDEGROOM.

And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bride-chamber mourn, as long as the *Bridegroom* is with them? but the days will come, when the *Bridegroom* shall be taken from them, and then shall they fast.—Matt. 9:15.

THE CAPTAIN OF OUR SALVATION.

For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the *Captain of their Salvation* perfect through sufferings.—Hcb. 2:10.

THE CHIEF CORNER STONE.

Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God; and are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the *Chief Corner Stone*.—Eph. 2:19, 20.

THE CARPENTER'S SON.

And when he was come into his own country, he taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said, Whence hath this man this wisdom, and these mighty works? Is not this the *Carpenter's Son*? is not his mother called Mary? and his brethren, James, and Joses, and Simon, and Judas?—Matt. 13:54, 55.

CHIEFEST AMONG TEN THOUSAND.

My beloved is white and ruddy, the *Chiefest among Ten Thousand*.—S. Song 5:10.

THE DELIVERER.

And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the *Deliverer*, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob.—Rom. 11:26.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE DOOR.

**Response.**—Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the *Door* of the sheep. By me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.—John 10:7, 9.

THE FIRST BEGOTTEN OF THE DEAD, AND THE PRINCE OF THE  
KINGS OF THE EARTH.

Grace be unto you, and peace from Jesus Christ, who is the *Faithful Witness* and the *First Begotten of the Dead*, and the *Prince of the Kings of the Earth*.—Rev. 1:4, 5.

FAITHFUL AND TRUE.

And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called *Faithful and True*, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.—Rev. 19:11.

MY FRIEND.

His mouth is most sweet: yea, he is altogether lovely. This is my beloved, and this is my *Friend*, O daughters of Jerusalem.—S. Song 5:16.

A FOUNTAIN.

In that day there shall be a *Fountain* opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.—Zech. 13:1.

A GOVERNOR.

And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Juda, art not the least among the princes of Juda: for out of thee shall come a *Governor*, that shall rule my people Israel.—Matt. 2:6.

GREAT HIGH PRIEST.

Seeing then that we have a *Great High Priest*, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession.—Heb. 4:14.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE HEAD.

**Response.**—For in him dwelleth all the fullness of the Godhead bodily. And ye are complete in him, who is *The Head* of all principality and power.—Col. 2:9, 10.

THE HOLY ONE, THE JUST, AND THE PRINCE OF LIFE.

But ye denied the *Holy One* and the *Just*, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you; and killed the *Prince of Life*, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses.—Acts 3:14, 15.

A HORN OF SALVATION.

Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, and hath raised up a *Horn of Salvation* for us in the house of his servant David.—Luke 1:68, 69.

THE HOPE OF GLORY.

Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: to whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the *Hope of Glory*.—Col. 1:26, 27.

IMMANUEL.

Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name *Immanuel*.—Isa. 7:14.

THE IMAGE OF GOD.

In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins. Who is the *Image of the Invisible God*, the firstborn of every creature.—Col. 1:14, 15.

THE KING OF THE JEWS.

Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem. Saying, Where is he that was born *King of the Jews*? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.—Matt. 2:1, 2.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE KING OF ISRAEL.

**Response.**—Nathaniel answered and saith unto him, *Rabbi*, thou art the *Son of God*; thou art the *King of Israel*.—John 1:49.

THE LAMB OF GOD.

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the *Lamb of God*, which taketh away the sin of the world!—John 1:29.

THE LAMB SLAIN FROM THE FOUNDATION OF THE WORLD.

And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, and all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the *Lamb Slain from the Foundation of the World*.—Rev. 13:1, 8.

A LEADER AND COMMANDER.

Behold, I have given him for a witness to the people, a *Leader* and *Commander* to the people.—Isa. 55:4.

THE LIVING BREAD.

I am the *Living Bread* which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.—John 6:51.

THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD.

Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the *Light of the World*: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.—John 8:12.

THE LION OF THE TRIBE OF JUDA.

And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the *Lion of the Tribe of Juda*, the *Root of David*, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.—Rev. 5:5.

THE LORD OF GLORY.

My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, *The Lord of Glory*, with respect of persons.—James 2:1.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE LORD OF LORDS AND KING OF KINGS.

**Response.**—These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them : for he is *Lord of lords*, and *King of kings* : and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.—Rev. 17:14.

THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely : and this is his name whereby he shall be called, *The Lord our Righteousness*.—Jer. 23:6.

THE MEDIATOR.

For there is one God, and one *Mediator* between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.—1 Tim. 2:5.

THE MESSIAS.

We have found the *Messias*, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.—John 1:41.

A MAN OF SORROWS.

He is despised and rejected of men ; a *Man of Sorrows*, and acquainted with grief : and we hid as it were our faces from him ; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.—Isa. 53:3.

THE MASTER.

Be not ye called Rabbi, for one is your *Master*, even Christ ; and all ye are brethren.—Matt. 23:8.

OUR PASSOVER.

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ *Our Passover* is sacrificed for us.—1 Cor. 5:7.

OUR LIFE.

When Christ, who is *Our Life*, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.—Col. 3:4.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE ONLY BEGOTTEN SON.

**Response.**—For God so loved the world, that he gave his *Only Begotten Son*, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.—John 3:16.

A PRINCE AND A SAVIOUR.

And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a *Saviour*, which is Christ the Lord.—Luke 2:10, 11.

The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree. Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a *Prince* and a *Saviour*, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.—Acts 5:30, 31.

And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be *The Saviour of the world*.—1 John 4:14.

THE PROPHET OF NAZARETH.

And when he was come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, Who is this? And the multitude said, This is Jesus the *Prophet of Nazareth* of Galilee.—Matt. 21:10, 11.

THE PROPITIATION.

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the *Propitiation* for our sins.—1 John 4:10.

A QUICKENING SPIRIT.

And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a *Quickening Spirit*.—1 Cor. 15:45.

THE ROOT AND THE OFFSPRING OF DAVID, THE BRIGHT AND  
THE MORNING STAR.

I Jesus have sent my angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the *Root* and the *Offspring of David*, and the *Bright and Morning Star*.—Rev. 22:16.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, ROOT OF JESSE.

**Response**—And in that day there shall be a *Root of Jesse*, which shall stand for an ensign of the people ; to it shall the Gentiles seek : and his rest shall be glorious.—Isa. 11:10.

THE ROCK.

Our fathers drank of that spiritual *Rock* that followed them: and that *Rock* was Christ.—1 Cor. 10:1, 4.

THE RIGHTEOUS JUDGE.

Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the *Righteous Judge*, shall give me at that day : and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.—2 Tim. 4:8.

THE GOOD SHEPHERD.

I am the *Good Shepherd* : the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.—John 10:11.

THAT GREAT SHEPHERD.

Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that *Great Shepherd* of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you perfect in every good work.—Heb. 13:20, 21.

THE CHIEF SHEPHERD.

And when the *Chief Shepherd* shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away. —1 Peter 5:4.

THE SON OF THE HIGHEST.

He shall be great, and shall be called the *Son of the Highest* ; and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David.—Luke 1:32.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE SON OF MAN.

**Response.**—And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant. Even as the *Son of Man* came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.—Matt. 20:27, 28.

THE SON OF DAVID.

And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou *Son of David*.—Matt. 20:30.

THE SHEPHERD AND BISHOP.

For ye were as sheep going astray ; but are now returned unto the *Shepherd* and *Bishop* of your souls.—1 Pet. 2:25.

THY SAVIOUR AND THY REDEEMER, THE MIGHTY ONE OF JACOB.

And all flesh shall know that I the Lord am thy *Saviour* and thy *Redeemer*, the *Mighty One of Jacob*.—Isa. 49:26.

THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED.

Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the Scriptures, *The Stone which the builders rejected*, the same is become the head of the corner.—Matt. 21:42.

A TEACHER COME FROM GOD.

There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a *Teacher come from God*: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.—John 3: 1, 2.

THE VINE.

I am the *Vine*, ye are the branches. He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit ; for without me ye can do nothing.—John 15:5.

**Leader.**—JESUS CHRIST, THE WAY, THE TRUTH, AND THE LIFE.

**Response.**—Jesus saith unto him, I am *The Way, The Truth,* and *The Life*: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.—John 14:6.

THE WORD.

And the *Word* was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.—John 1:14.

WONDERFUL, COUNSELLOR, THE MIGHTY GOD, THE EVERLASTING  
FATHER, THE PRINCE OF PEACE.

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given : and the government shall be upon his shoulders : and his name shall be called *Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.*—Isa. 9:6.

THE SON OF GOD.

But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, *The Son of God* ; and that believing ye might have life through his name.—John 20:31.
